To Whom it may concern:

Within the city of Colorado Springs, Co. we have an emergency fleet of approximately 80 front line heavy fire apparatus in 20 stations. Our equipment must perform in all types of weather conditions from 90 + degree temperatures during summer to - 15 or more in winter, severe thunders storms to blizzard conditions.

Currently we have 12 Hart-A-Gen generator systems on front line apparatus. We have specified the Hart-A-Gen generator for 6 new purchased apparatus and 3 refurbished units this year. We can strongly testify that the systems perform exceptionally well in our situation and conditions. The remaining apparatus in our fleet are equipped with gasoline or diesel generators that require much more in maintenance, repair, and down time. The ease, simplicity of operation, and little maintenance makes the Hart-A-Gen system a must in our specifications.

We would highly recommend the system to any department that is looking for a near trouble free generator for emergency equipment.
